

**A Brief Report on One Day Faculty Development Programme on  
“Financial Statement Analysis” organised by the Department of Studies  
and Research in Commerce, Karnataka State Open University,  
Mukthagangothri, Mysuru.**

One day Faculty Development Programme on “Financial Statement Analysis” was organised on 25<sup>th</sup> January 2023 by the Department of Studies and Research in Commerce, Karnataka State Open University, Mysuru. This programme was organised specially of the Commerce and Management Faculties and Research Scholars. Total of 194 (One Hundred Ninety Four) participants were registered including 12 (twelve) faculties from Commerce and Management Department, Karnataka State Open University, Mysuru and 7 (seven) staffs of Finance section and Finance Officer of Karnataka State Open University, Mysuru. Participants are the faculties and research scholars from different affiliated colleges and universities across the states.

The FDP covered various aspects of analysing the financial statements of a company using various models which can be evaluated on the basis of past, current, and projected performance. This programme was designed to bridge the gap between industry and institutional competency in the field of Commerce and Management.

**Aim:** The main aim of FDP is to strengthen the professional development of Commerce and Management Faculties. This FDP aims to equip the participants in the domain of Accounting and Finance with subject-specific knowledge. It aids to provide exhaustive knowledge on financial models and to equip the participants in analyzing case studies.

**FDP Highlights:** The programme covered with following aspects.

1. Orientation to Financial Statements
2. DU PONT Model for Financial Statement Analysis
3. Piotroski ‘F’ Score, Modified ‘C’ Score, Altman’s Z Score and Beneish M Score
4. Cases on Financial Statement Analysis

Registration for the workshop started at 9.00 am followed by the Inaugural session, Technical Session – I, Technical Session – II, Technical Session – III and Technical Session – IV and Open Discussion and Distribution of Certificates as per the schedule. The programme was anchored by Dr. Shilpa N.C., Assistant Professor, MIT, Thandavapura, Nanjangud Taluk,

Mysuru. Smt. Usha C., Chairperson and Programme Director, Department of Studies and Research in Commerce, Karnataka State Open University, Mysuru, welcomed all the dignitaries and participants and briefed the participants about the objectives of the Faculty Development Programme and introduced the participants with a brief description of our University.

The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Rajesh Kumar V., Professor and Dean, School of Commerce and Management, Chanakya University, Bangalore. Dr. Shilpa N.C., introduced the resource person and the resource person gave a brief description about the importance and need for conducting this faculty development programme on “financial statement analysis”.

The first Technical Session was started at 11.00 am by the resource person, Dr. V. Rajesh Kumar, Professor and Dean of Chanakya University. He gave a brilliant and insightful discourse on the overview of financial statements and the methods and models used to analyse the financial statement. In the second technical session, he emphasized on the DU-PONT Model for analysing the financial statement. He throw a light on the aspect that how with only one parameters, financial statements like income statement, balance sheet and cash flow statement can be analysed to know the present profitability and financial position of the company compared to the previous year.

After the lunch break, the third session was started by 2.00pm, continued by the same resource person. He discussed on various financial models and gave an insight into some of

the financial models like Piotroski 'F' Score, Modified 'C' Score, Altman's Z Score and Beneish M Score for analysing the financial statements.

In the fourth Technical session, the resource person analysed the cases of financial statements by taking some companies like HUL, Reliance and other companies previous year's financial statements. All the participants were actively involved in all the sessions through interaction and various activities like group discussion and case study analysis. The session was concluded by Valedictory. Vote of thanks was delivered by Smt. Usha C., Chairperson of the Commerce Department, KSOU, Mysuru.

The FDP concluded with distribution of certificates to the participants.
