About the University:

Karnataka State Open University (KSOU), Mysuru, is a State Public University established by the act of State Legislature in 1992, and was brought into force on 1st June 1996. Ever since its establishment, KSOU has been pro-actively engaged in fulfilling the national objectives of higher education i.e., to achieve ACCESS, EQUITY, QUALITY, AFFORDABILITY and ACCOUNTABILITY.

A Pioneer and Premier Centre of Higher Education under Open and Distance Learning (ODL) system, KSOU was carved out of illustrious University of Mysore in 1996. Before becoming the university, KSOU was an Institute of Correspondence Courses and Continuing Education (ICC&CE) of the University of Mysore which was established in 1969.

The motto of KSOU - "HIGHER EDUCATION FOR EVERYONE, EVERYWHERE", promises to reach out to those unreached - to all those higher education aspirants. The Open University was established in pursuance of National Policy on Education, NPE-1986 on the recommendation of Central Education Advisory Board MHRD, Government of India.

The working professionals, households, the disadvantaged sections of the society and people from backward regions, who cannot pursue education through 'inclass'/conventional mode get new opportunities to learn through distance education mode.



The Karnataka State is a leading state in the higher education sector with a GER of 25.3% (for 2018-19, AISHE), the role of KSOU is vital in enhancing the GER of the state to much higher level. The KSOU has created an excellent academic and administrative infrastructure, not only at its headquarters in Mysore, but also at its 21 regional centers across the state.

Headed by His Excellency, the Governor of Karnataka, who is the Ex-Officio Chancellor, while the Minister for Higher Education is the Ex-Officio Pro-Chancellor, and the Vice-Chancellor is the principal Academic and Executive officer of the university, the KSOU is a body corporate comprising of the Chancellor, Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, the members of BoM, Academic Council, Dean (Academic), Registrar (Evaluation), Finance officer among other officers of the university.

The contribution of the KSOU for the ODL system is invaluable. With the entire State has its jurisdiction, KSOU has established 21 Regional Centers, in addition to recognizing a good number of affiliated Colleges as Study Centers across the State. Significant is the role of KSOU in enhancing the GER of the State. In terms of providing quality and relevant education, the role of KSOU is commendable. The Courses, Curriculum, Study Materials, Contact Classes, Method of Testing, Transparency in the conduct of Examination, Evaluation and announcement of results.

The quality of SLMs, Radio talks, audio-video lecturers produced 'in-house studios' housed on the main campus have earned the admiration of a large community of distance learners across the Country as well as outside the Country. MBA, M. Com, Media studies, MA and Education Programs are some of the most sought-after courses among others.

Admission to courses is done twice-a-year in the month of January and June as per the UGC-DEB guidelines, and the admissions are done online. Access to E-content, E-access to SLM's, Books and journals in the main library; on-line lectures are additional advantages to KSOU students. Establishment of Science labs, Audio-Video, virtual labs, Re-establishment of Radio station – 'JNANA VANI' are among the notable digital initiatives, the KSOU has launched since the re-recognition of KSOU by UGC from 2018-19.

Well-known is KSOU for its students support services - establishment of Skill Development Center; Training Center for competitive Examinations, Campus Recruitment drives, online and off-line counselling; on-line admission; digital payments of all kinds of fee payment are some of the pro-student recent undertakings of the KSOU.

Lodging facilities in Hostels for students coming for coaching classes, Skill development programs and Contact classes in a clean-green environment is yet another student support service. With state of the academic infrastructure; online and off-line student support, KSOU is a dream institution for distance learners.

Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA):



The meeting of AAA committee was fixed on 16.09.2021. The AAA committee was assisted by the CIQA Director and members for conducting the audit. The Committee had a formal meeting with the Vice-chancellor and Registrar, Dean (Academic), Head of Departments and the coordinators during which the Director CIQA presented the overview of the university, developments and the achievements made. Members of the Committee were briefed about the objective of the audit and the procedure involved.

The members visited the departments, from 19.09.2022 to 21.09.2022 in a two batch to inspect the infrastructural facilities in the department such as classrooms, laboratories and interacted with the teaching staff and the technical staff to know the academic and administrative performance. All the related documents were presented to the members. After completing all stages of inspection and interactions in the department, AAA Report covering the observations was prepared for the respective departments by the member. Individual department evaluation sheets are enclosed with this report. Also, the

members visited the central facilities such as Examination section, IT Section, Finance Section, Admission, General Section, Computer center, placement cell, library and auditorium, and had interactions with the coordinators. Other general facilities were also verified.

Further, the Committee after completing all stages of inspection and interactions prepared the AAA report for the university covering the summarized observations and recommendations.

Academic and Administrative Audit for last 5 years

We, the members of the Academic and Administrative Audit team have conducted the Academic and Administrative Audit for the academic year 2017-18 to 2021-22 (05 years) of Karnataka State Open University, Mukthagangotri, Mysuru-06. During 19.09.2022 to 21.09.2022.

The marks obtained are 713 out of 1000 (71.3%)

Observations of Auditors:

- Curricular Aspects and Examinations processes are progressing periodically in various departments of the university. While designing the curriculum proper care should be taken by the BOS of the concerned for maintaining overall quality and design the syllabus as per the industry expectations. Emphasis should be laid on introduction of new courses/Skill based courses in their domain.
- The university may take note of the fact that the enrolment in some programs is low. It is opined that the university may take appropriate steps to increase the enrolment in those program giving more thrust to those departments.
- 3. The university may make provision for involvement of industry representative in Board of Studies and curricular development activities which in turn will help to develop and introduce skill based curriculum.
- 4. It is noticed that few departments have failed to maintain the student's feedback reports. The committee recommend the university to insist the department concerned to collect the feedback regularly and submit to CIQA for analysis.
- 5. Separate mechanism to be developed for disseminating the outcome of the students feedback analysis to the department concerned for further improvement.
- 6. The Faculty Members in each department needs be motivated and encouraged to actively take part in the research and publications. They should be encouraged properly to involve in consultancy and collaboration with the industry.
- 7. The IPR and Placement Cell needs to be more vibrant in the university.
- 8. It is recommended to the University for Regular Maintenance of the buildings with structured mechanism.

- 9. It is noticed that few departments have failed to follow the academic calendar. The university may take note of it to bring the parity among other programs.
- 10. Proper Communication flow has to be ensured among different divisions of the university including Regional Centres and Learner Support Centre.
